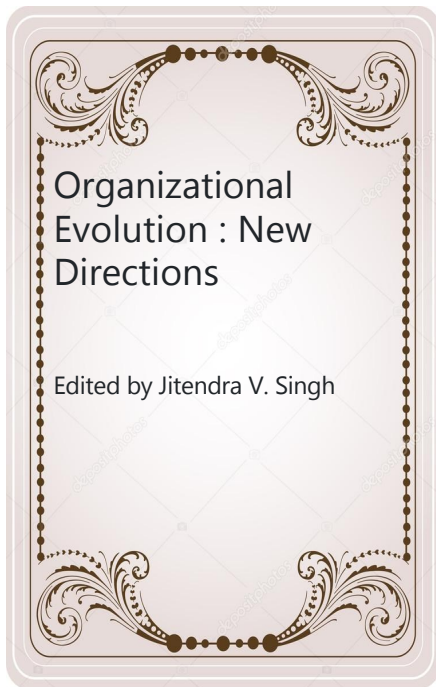


Organizational Evolution : New Directions
